The Feast of the Baptism of the Lord this Sunday brings the Christmas season to an end. From Monday 12th January we will begin Ordinary Time in the Church calendar, which will run until Ash Wednesday (18th February). For those who recite the Divine Office, we will be using Week 1 of the Psalter.
